NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING HELD Monday, December 2, 2019

Notice is hereby given, that a **Public Hearing** was held before the **Village of Wrightstown Board of Appeals**, Brown/Outagamie Counties, Wisconsin, on **Monday, December 2, 2019 at 4:00 p.m.** at **Village Hall, Conference Room C, 352 High St, Wrightstown, Wisconsin**, for the purpose of hearing from all persons and/or their agents on the following request:

Application for a variance from Municipal Ordinance 75-9 Limit on Number of Dogs by Steve J. & Jolene E. Ducat, 1037 Crestview Dr., Wrightstown, WI 54180

Requested to allowed ownership of (4) four dogs over (5) five months of age.

Ordinance §75-9 states that no person, except a kennel licensee, shall own, harbor or keep more than three dogs that are more than five months of age except in a place or places where animals are impounded by the Village. If a total of more than three dogs are owned, harbored or kept in or by any one household, the head of the household shall be deemed the person so owning, harboring or keeping such dogs, notwithstanding that the dog licensee or licenses may be issued to other members of the household as owners of such animals.

The Board of Appeals members, after review of Village Ordinance 75-9, hearing from applicants Steve J. and Jolene E. Ducat and neighbors Marilyn Maynard and James and Kathleen Ollman, approved a temporary variance request with the following conditions:

- The variance will immediately be revoked if the police are called (and able to verify) any dog related ordinance violation relating to Echo (Pug Mix), Max (Cavalier King), Xenia (Mastiff Mix) or Lola (Bison Mix)
- The unregistered Bison Mix (Lola) must be immediately registered
- The limit of (3) dogs, never again be exceeded, once any one of the current dogs listed, passes away
