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Ordinance Section 139-16 Open Burning

[Amended 8-16-1994 by Ord. No. 081694A]

No combustible materials, waste, rubbish, grass, leaves, construction debris or other refuse shall be burned outdoors in the Village at any time or any place whatever except as follows:

A. (Reserved)[1]

[1] Editor's Note: Former Subsection A, regarding only commercial or manufacturing companies being allowed to burn combustible waste, was repealed 2-17-2003 by Ord. No. 02172003A

B. Nothing in this section is intended to prohibit the operation of outdoor grills or fireplaces for outdoor cooking nor shall recreational fires (campfires) be prohibited as long as they do not exceed 36 inches in diameter. [Amended 2-17-2003 by Ord. No. 02172003A]

C. Nothing in this section shall prohibit the burning of leaves in the months of April, May, October and November, provided that the burning is done in a safe and proper manner and a burning permit is obtained and is restricted to between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. [Amended 3-1-2022 by Ord. No. 03012022A]

D. The Fire Inspector of the Village of Wrightstown has the authority to enforce the provisions of this section.

E. Any violation of the provisions of this section is punishable by the forfeitures in Chapter 1, General Provisions, § 1-18.

F. The Fire Inspector has the authority to revoke any burning permit at any given time without notice due to safety concerns, weather related issues, or any other issues that they see fit.

G. Any violations of the provisions of this section is punishable by the forfeiture in Chapter 1, General Provisions, § 1-18.

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
