Fall Partisan Primary and Special Congressional Primary Election: Tuesday, August 13, 2024

VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT BROWN COUNTY, WISCONSIN

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may submit a request to vote an absentee ballot to their Municipal clerk. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen, who will be 18 years of age or older on Election Day, who has resided in the ward or municipality where they wish to vote for at least 28 consecutive days before the election. The elector must also be registered to vote in order to receive an absentee ballot. Proof of identification must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued*.

MAKING APPLICATION TO RECEIVE AN ABSENTEE BALLOT BY MAIL

Contact your Municipal clerk and request that an application for an absentee ballot be sent to you for the primary or election or both. You may make written application to your Municipal clerk for an absentee ballot by mail, by fax, by email or at MyVote.wi.gov. Or you may apply in person at the clerk's office during the In-Person Absentee Voting period listed on the following page. Your written request must include your voting address within the municipality where you wish to vote, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, (if different from residency address), your signature and a copy of your photo identification*.

THE DEADLINE FOR MAKING APPLICATION TO VOTE ABSENTEE BY MAIL IS:

5 P.M. ON THE FIFTH DAY BEFORE THE ELECTION, THURSDAY, AUGUST 8, 2024**.

*Voters who are indefinitely confined due to age, illness, infirmity, or disability may not be required to provide photo ID. If this applies to you, contact the Municipal clerk regarding deadlines for requesting and submitting an absentee ballot.

**Special absentee voting application provisions apply to electors who are indefinitely confined, in the military, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact the municipal clerk regarding deadlines for requesting and submitting an absentee ballot.

VOTING AN ABSENTEE BALLOT IN PERSON

You may also request and vote an absentee ballot in the Municipal clerk's office or other specified location during the days and hours specified for casting an absentee ballot in person.

THE FIRST DAY TO VOTE AN ABSENTEE BALLOT IN THE MUNICIPAL CLERK'S OFFICE IS LISTED ON THE FOLLOWING PAGE. THE DEADLINE FOR VOTING AN ABSENTEE BALLOT IS ON THE SUNDAY BEFORE THE ELECTION, AUGUST 11, 2024.

No in-person absentee voting may occur on the day before the election.

The Municipal clerk will deliver voted ballots returned on or before Election Day to the proper polling place or counting location before the polls close on August 13, 2024. Any ballots received after the polls close will not be counted.

Type A Notice of Referendum Election

State of Wisconsin

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that at an election to be held in the several towns, villages, cities, wards, and election districts of the State of Wisconsin, on Tuesday, August 13, 2024, the following questions will be submitted to a vote of the people pursuant to law:

QUESTION 1: "Delegation of appropriation power. Shall section 35 (1) of article IV of the constitution be created to provide that the legislature may not delegate its sole power to determine how moneys shall be appropriated?"

QUESTION 2: "Allocation of federal moneys. Shall section 35 (2) of article IV of the constitution be created to prohibit the governor from allocating any federal moneys the governor accepts on behalf of the state without the approval of the legislature by joint resolution or as provided by legislative rule?"
